For every question, only one option is correct. 3 marks will be awarded for each correct response and 1 mark will be deducted for each incorrect response. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Medical aspirants should attempt <b>Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Logical Reasoning</b>.</li> <li>Engineering aspirants should attempt <b>Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Logical Reasoning</b>.</li> </ul> 2. Candidates must reach Test Centre by 08:30 AM on December 17, 2017. 3. Under any circumstance, no candidate will be allowed to enter the Test Centre after the commencement of the examination. 4. Candidates must preserve the Authorization Letter till the final selection. 5. No candidate without Admit Card/Authorization Letter shall be allowed to appear for the examination. 6. Candidates must carry following things to the examination hall <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dakshana Admit Card/ Authorization Letter issued by School Principal</li> <li>Two Natraj HB pencils, blue/black ball point pen, an eraser, and a sharpener.</li> <li>One recent color passport size photograph (photo should be same as that pasted on the Authorization letter)</li> <li>School Identity Card.</li> </ul> 7.
