[Dakshana Foundation](#) is pleased to announce that its 10th batch of Dakshana Scholars came through with flying colours and did exceedingly well in the JEE Mains 2018.

A total of 406 Scholars, who underwent a 2-year coaching program fully sponsored by Dakshana, appeared for JEE Mains 2018. Additionally, 112 scholars, who underwent a 1-year coaching program fully sponsored by Dakshana, also appeared for JEE Mains 2018. Of these, 496 have qualified for the next round. Last year, 447 Dakshana scholars took the JEE and 389 scholars cracked the JEE – a success rate of 87.02%.

Dakshana's topper for 2018 is Yuvraj Garg from Baran district in Rajasthan. Yuvraj secured a JEE All-India rank of 280. Yuvraj was intensively coached for the JEE at JNV Bundi from 2016. This year, Dakshana had 05 scholars in the Top 1000 JEE ranks:

2. Akram Khan (441)
3. Vaskar Borai (756)
4. Sourabh Singh Tiwari (812)
5. Sourabh Kumar (939)

Around 10,43,739 students attempted the JEE Mains this year. Dakshana had a hit rate of 95.75%, with 496 of the 518 scholars being selected for JEE Advanced.
