Scholars must report to their allotted location on the joining dates. In case a scholar does not report to his/her JNV Centre of Excellence, his/her seat will be allotted to the next waitlisted scholar. Please ask your JNV Principal about arrangements for your travel and transfer.

## **Please bring with you:**

- School Identity Card
- Letter from the Parent JNV confirming the scholar's admission to the allotted COE.
- 2 copies of Family Income Certificate (dated after January 01, 2019)
- 2 copies of Caste Certificate
- 2 copies of PwD Certificate (if applicable)
- 2 copies of Aadhar Card
- (Note that the name and DOB in Aadhar card must be same as in the Class X certificate. Students must apply for correction NOW if there is any mismatch.)
- 2 copies of Class X Mark sheets
- Original Health Record from Parent JNV (Health record must be recent - last 3 months latest)
- Copy of Bio-data & application for admission submitted to Parent JNV at Class VI duly attested by the Principal.
- Eight passport-size photos
- Textbooks, notebooks, uniform, tracksuit, T-shirt, nightdress (sky blue in colour), warm clothes and all the stationery etc., which are supplied by the Parent JNV.
- Letter for combination of subjects to be selected for study in Class XI/XII signed by the parent, student & Principal.
- An application with name, address, photo of guardian/relative, who will be visiting the scholar regularly, attested by Principal. Their relation to the selected students must be mentioned in the application (Only those visitors will be allowed).

### **Important Information:**

- Selections are made based on information provided by the student in the Dakshana Scholar Application Form. Any misappropriation or misinformation could result in termination or withdrawal of the studentship at any point of time.
- Selected students must be willing to join the course and to stay continuously at the assigned JNV for a period of 24 months until they appear for the JEE Advanced/NEET 2021. No vacation will be declared till then. Kindly note that no request for leave to attend family weddings/functions or religious ceremonies will be entertained during the course of the two years. A scholar leaving the program without permission from Dakshana and the JNV COE's Principal will lose his/her studentship and will not be allowed to re-join the program.
- Selected students must stay in school till JEE Advanced/NEET exam. Those students who do not qualify for the JEE Advanced will be allowed to leave the school ONLY on the day of the JEE Main results.
- No mobile phones are allowed to be held by the selected students during the two-year Dakshana program.
- We have made best efforts to create regionally homogenous batches as far as possible. Please do not make any request for change of center. Centers once allotted remain final.
- **No TC should be brought by the scholar. TC will be issued only by Parent JNV (where the student has completed Class 10) after the CBSE Class 12 exam.**

### **Discipline Clause:**

- All the selected students are required to follow the daily routine of respective COEs strictly, any deviation from the same will result in immediate termination of scholarship.
- Usage of electronic items like mobile phone, camera, tab etc. is strictly prohibited during the entire scholarship programme.
